Personal Definition:

SPIRITUAL GIFT – √ A ministry characteristic of the Holy Spirit,

- $\sqrt{}$ which God has given me in special abundance,
- $\sqrt{}$ through which I can supernaturally serve the body of Christ, the church

This week: KEYS TO YOUR DISCOVERY (of "Spirituals" in you) v. 4-31

1. Spirituals come in VARIETY v. 4 - 6

- 4 Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit.
- 5 And there are varieties of ministries, and the same Lord.
- There are varieties of <u>effects</u>, but the same God who works all things in all *persons*.
 - a. Note "varieties" in all 3 verses lit. "distributions" implying the uniqueness of "spirituals" in every individual
 - b. Note "gifts", "ministries" and "effects" (NIV: gifts, service, working)
 - (1) many kinds of gifts (v. 4)
 - (2) many ways the gifts can be used, in combination (v. 4)
 - (3) many results the gifts can have (v. 5)
 - c. Example of "jelly bellys" many flavors, many combos, many combo flavors
 - d. Note "one Spirit", "one Lord", "one God"
 - (1) This indicates that all the infinite combinations are part of our one God
 - (2) Each person of the Godhead is reflected
 - (a) The GIFTS are the specific ministry character of the Spirit
 - (b) The MINISTRY is the ministry of Jesus the head, working through His body, the church
 - (c) The RESULTS are by our good and gracious Heavenly Father
 - e. Note the Greek words used each a facet of a what a spiritual gift is
 - (1) v. 1 "pneuma t ikon" a characteristic of the Holy Spirit
 - (2) v. 4 "charisma" (charity) lit. grace gift a free gift of God

 I am a charismatic Christian! given a "grace gift" by God
 - (3) v. 5 "diakonion" (deacon) a "service" or "ministry" done for others
 - (4) v. 6 "energeo" (energy) a supernatural power

2. Spirituals are ASSIGNED v. 7-11

- 7 But to each one is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good.
- 8 For to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, and to another the word of knowledge according to the same Spirit;
 - 9 to another faith by the same Spirit, and to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit,
- and to another the effecting of miracles, and to another prophecy, and to another the distinguishing of spirits, to another *various* kinds of tongues, and to another the interpretation of tongues.
- 11 But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually just as He wills.
 - a. A visible assigning "Manifestation" in v. 7 means a visible display of the Spirit just as Jesus was a visible display or "manifestation" of God
 - b. The Holy Spirit assigns "just as He wills" (v. 11) Note every verse mentions or implies the Spirit's leading in the distribution
 - c. For the good of the church "for the common good" (v.7)
 - d. <u>Uniquely to each</u> "to each one individually" lit: "idios (idiot) = peculiar, one of a kind (unique gifting like a snowflake is unique)
 - e. Implied: No exchanging! No trading! No complaining!

3. Spirituals are <u>FOCUSED</u>: for one body through one Spirit (v. 12, 13)

- 12 For even as the <u>body</u> is <u>one</u> and *yet* has many members, and all the members of the body, though they are many, are <u>one body</u>, so also is Christ.
- For by <u>one Spirit</u> we were all baptized into <u>one body</u>, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to drink of one Spirit.
 - a. <u>True of each individual CHURCH BODY</u> emphasis in v. 12 We are one, but with many members (or parts) just as Christ's body is one, yet has many parts. The many are ONE, all a part of the ONE Christ.
 - b. <u>True of the UNIVERSAL BODY</u> emphasis in v. 13 We were all <u>individually</u> baptized (lit: immersed) by the Spirit (the "one true baptism") into <u>one body</u>. The many are ONE. And all drink of the ONE Spirit

4. My spiritual is <u>CRITICAL</u> FOR THE MANY (v. 14 - 19) or "I am not an appendix"! Emphasis: INDIVIDUALITY / Independence

- 14 For the body is <u>not one member, but many</u>.
- 15 If the foot should say, "Because I am not a hand, I am not a part of the

- body," it is not for this reason any the less a part of the body.
- 16 And if the ear should say, "Because I am not an eye, I am not a part of the body," it is not for this reason any the less a part of the body.
- 17 If the whole body were an eye, where would the hearing be? If the whole were hearing, where would the sense of smell be?
- 18 But now God has placed the members, each one of them, in the body, just as He desired.
- 19 If they were all one member, where would the body be?
 - a. As a Christian, I am "a part" of the whole whether I realize it or not
 - b. My spiritual is essential for the proper functioning of the whole
 - c. The church is missing something without my spiritual in action

5. My spiritual is $\underline{\mathsf{DEFICIENT}}$ to satisfy the ONE (v. 20 – 26)

or "I can't do it all" Emphasis: UNITY / Dependence

- 20 But now there are many members, but one body.
- And the eye cannot say to the hand, "I have no need of you"; or again the head to the feet, "I have no need of you."
- On the contrary, it is much truer that the members of the body which seem to be weaker are necessary;
- and those *members* of the body which we deem less honorable, on these we bestow more abundant honor, and our unseemly *members come to* have more abundant seemliness,
 - 24 whereas our seemly *members* have no need *of it*. But God has so composed the body, giving more abundant honor to that *member* which lacked,
 - a. We desperately need one another's "spirituals"
 - b. "I couldn't do it without you " extra emphasis for others
 - **c.** Those who think they might be less important need more encouragement

6. My spiritual is about <u>CARING</u> for the body v. 25 - 26)

- so that there may be <u>no division</u> in the body, but *that* the members may have the <u>same care for one another</u>.
- And if one member suffers, <u>all the members suffer with it</u>; if one member is honored, <u>all the members rejoice with it</u>.
 - a. We act as one ("no divisions")

- b. We care as one ("same care for one another")
- c. We suffer as one ("all the members suffer with it")
- d. We rejoice as one ("all the members rejoice with it")

7. The key to my spiritual is **INTERDEPENDENCE** (summary)

- 27 Now you are <u>Christ's body</u>, and <u>individually members</u> of it.
- And God has appointed in the church, first apostles, second prophets, third teachers, then miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, administrations, *various* kinds of tongues.
- All are not apostles, are they? All are not prophets, are they? All are not teachers, are they? All are not *workers of* miracles, are they?
- 30 I do not have gifts of healings, do they? All do not speak with tongues, do they? All do not interpret, do they?
 - a. Spirituals contribute to a CRITICAL WHOLE ("Christ's body)
 - b. Spirituals are a CRITICAL PART of the whole ("individually members")
 - c. GOD APPOINTS the various leaders and gifts ("God has appointed")
 - d. Spirituals are INTERDEPENDENT ("all are not. . . are they?")
